## The FAFSA is available October 1st for students who plan to attend college in 2021-2022.

- There's money available to help pay for college, but you must file the FAFSA to be considered for financial aid.
- Filing the FAFSA can be the first step in the college application process. It's available October 1.
- You don't need to know all the schools you are applying to or if you are even going to college. List at least one school; additional schools can be added later.
