File Your FAFSA at FAFSA.gov

The FAFSA is available **October 1st** for students who plan to attend college in **2021–2022**.

- **There's money available** to help pay for college, but you must file the FAFSA to be considered for financial aid.
- Filing the FAFSA can be the first step in the college application process. **It's available October 1.**
- You don't need to know all the schools you are applying to or if you are even going to college. List at least one school; additional schools can be added later.
