The FSA ID

- The FSA ID allows students to access FSA Web sites, including FAFSA on the Web.
- It is also the fastest way for students and parents to sign the FAFSA.
- An FSA ID is made up of a username and password and can be created at fsaid.ed.gov.





Creating an FSA ID

- Go to: fsaid.ed.gov
- As with the retired PIN, EVERY STUDENT and ONE PARENT of a dependent student will need an FSA ID to sign the FAFSA electronically.

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The FSA ID

- It is recommended that students and parents obtain FSA IDs ahead of time.
- Each FSA ID takes about 10 minutes to create.
- If a student is ready to do the FAFSA but doesn't have an FSA ID, have the student create the FSA as the first step in the FAFSA process.





FSA ID Tips

- Critical that information being entered is correct (especially name, social security number, and date of birth)!
- Write down the information used when creating the FSA ID (use FAME's <u>FSA ID Information</u> <u>Tracking Sheet</u>).
- An email address can only be used once (student and parent can't use the same email address).





FSA ID Tips

- Students shouldn't use their high school email address if they have an alternative.
- It is important to have access to email when creating the FSA ID
 - Secure code can be sent (and then retrieved and entered) resulting in a verified email.
 - Having a verified email will make retrieval of username and passwords easier.





FSA ID Tips

- The FSA ID can be used immediately to access and sign the FAFSA.
- However, the FSA ID can't be used to update or correct the FAFSA or enter any other FSA websites until it has been verified with the Social Security Administration (1-3 days).


Dependency Status Results

You may submit your FAFSA without parental information. However, we will not calculate your Expected Family Contribution (EFC), which is the index used by colleges to determine how much student aid you are eligible to receive. Only your financial aid administrator can make the determination that you meet the homeless conditions and are therefore not required to provide parental information.

If you are able to get written evidence of your situation from people like school counselors, social workers, service providers, or clergy, you should provide this information to your financial aid administrator.

If you are not able to obtain written evidence of your homeless status, your financial aid administrator may make a determination about your status based on a documented interview with you. After reviewing your circumstances carefully, your financial aid administrator will decide if you meet the homeless conditions.

Remember, we will not calculate your EFC until you have received a determination of homeless status from your financial aid administrator. You should be aware of any approaching deadlines for your state, college, or scholarship aid.
