5 Ways FAME Can Help Maine Students

FAME helps Maine students reach their higher education goals by providing free information on planning, saving and paying for college. Here are five FAME services, tools and upcoming events available to help Mainers prepare and pay for higher education.

1. Statewide Financial Aid Presentations

FAME Financial Aid and College Financing presentations are held at high schools, career and technical educational schools, Adult Education centers, and other community-based organizations throughout Maine. These presentations provide an overview of the financial aid process, including step-by-step tips to help families navigate and simplify the process and maximize financial aid eligibility. 2. In-Person FAFSA Help Sessions

In October, FAME will hold 15 In-Person FAFSA help sessions located throughout Maine. At each of these sessions, FAME staff and other financial aid professionals will be available to help students and families complete the FAFSA online and receive information on the next steps in the financial aid process. Additionally, students who attend an event can be entered to win a scholarship. Click here to find a session near you.

3. Online Tools and Resources

Having the right "tools" makes any job a little easier. For example, trying to compare award letters from multiple colleges to get an "apples to apples" comparison can be difficult. To help, we've developed a <u>Comparing Costs & Financial Aid Awards</u> online tool and it will even do the math! Other tools include a <u>Student Loan/Salary Debt Calculator</u>, <u>FSA ID Information Tracking Sheet</u>, and <u>Get Ready to File the FAFSA Checklist</u>. 4. Videos and Online Tutorials

Videos have become the way many people prefer to learn, with YouTube being a primary source of information. To help people learn about a variety of topics related to paying for college, FAME has its own YouTube channel — FAME Maine. Subscribe to FAME's YouTube channel and gain easy access to videos that range from filling the FAFSA to tips on paying the tuition bill. An added advantage of these videos is that they are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week.



Alfond Leaders

The Alfond Leaders student debt reduction program provides student loan repayment assistance to people who live and work in Maine in a STEM- (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) designated occupation at a Maine-based employer. Alfond Leaders may qualify for loan repayment up to half of their outstanding student loan balance at the time of application to the program, not to exceed \$60,000.

A complete application and all required documents are due to FAME on or before the application deadline, this includes: your online application, official college transcripts, current resume, copy of all loan statements, and the employer certification completed by your employer.

The fall 2017 application collection period will be available September 15 - November 15, 2017.




