## Federal Student Aid Account (FSA ID)

- Creating a Federal Student Aid Account (FSA ID)
  - **EVERY STUDENT** needs an FSA ID.
  - If the student is **dependent**, **ONE PARENT** will need an FSA ID to sign the FAFSA (and use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool)
  - FSA IDs are tied to an individual's Social Security Number.
  - Use our FSA ID Information Tracking form to record information.
  - We recommend getting FSA IDs ahead of time.

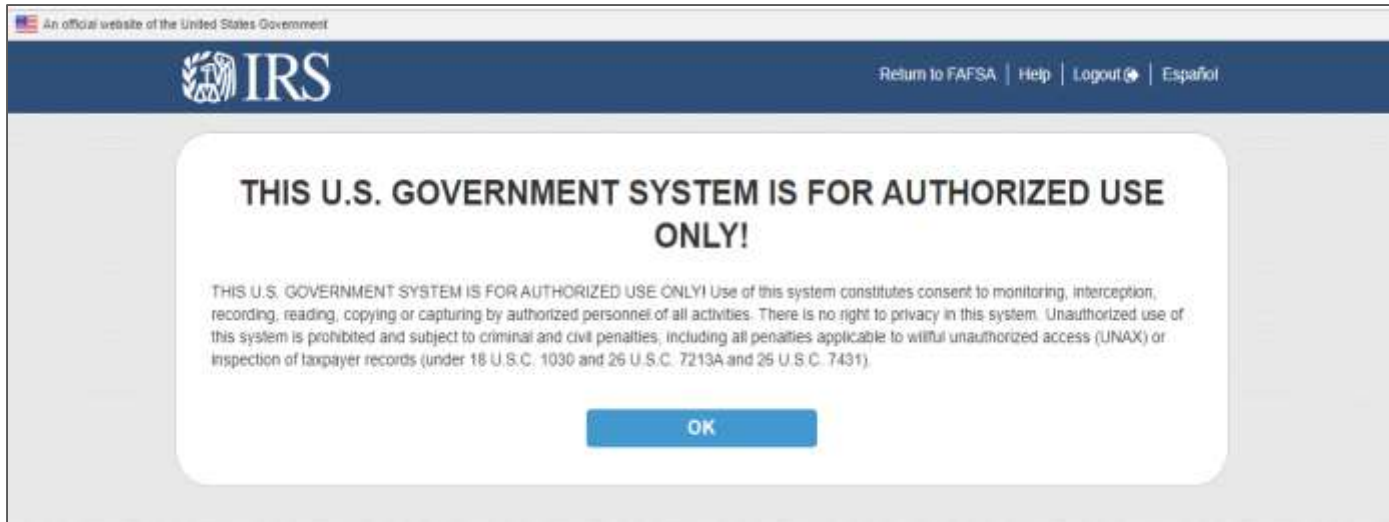


