In keeping with their long history of service to women, the Waterville Woman's Association has established a scholarship to help non-traditional female students pursue post-secondary education or training. The scholarship may be used for full or part-time study. Scholarship amounts vary based on need.

Criteria for Eligibility

- A woman who **resides** in the areas served by RSU 18, Waterville Public Schools, Winslow Public Schools, and MSAD #49 (specific towns include Oakland, Belgrade, Rome, Sidney, China, Fairfield, Albion, Benton, Clinton, Waterville, Winslow, Vassalboro).
- A **non-traditional student** which is defined as:
 - An interruption of formal education of two or more years since completion of high school
 - or**
 - A graduate of an adult education program
- Demonstrated **evidence of need** based on the FAFSA.

Application Procedure

- Complete the **application form**.
- Attach **one letter of recommendation** from a teacher, counselor, employer or community member (not a relative). Recommendation should include the name, address, and position of the person writing the recommendation.
- Attach a copy of the **FAFSA Student Aid Report (SAR)** showing your **Expected Family Contribution (EFC)**. **Please make sure that the EFC is clearly indicated on the Student Aid Report.**
- Send the application, letter of recommendation, and financial information by **May 1, 2021** to:

Award Procedure

1. Recipient will be notified by **May 31, 2021**
2. Scholarship will be **paid directly** to the institution.
3. Scholarship can be used for **tuition, fees, and books**.
4. Scholarship must be **used within one year from date of award letter**.
