REAPPLICATION for CURRENT COLLEGE STUDENTS
Applications must be postmarked no later than May 1, 2021

The Waterville Woman's Association awards *need-based scholarships* to qualified women who are residents of the Waterville, Oakland, Fairfield and Winslow areas, and who will attend an accredited nonprofit postsecondary institution in Maine during the next academic year.

The re-applicant must meet the following requirements:

1. Must have been accepted by an accredited non-profit postsecondary institution within the State of Maine.
2. Must have documented financial need.
3. Must have previously received a scholarship from the Waterville Woman's Association.
4. Must be a full time student during the 2021-2022 academic year.

Application requirements:

1. A completed REAPPLICATION FORM. All information requested must be included with the application.
2. A one page personal statement signed by the applicant that includes reasons for your continuing need of financial assistance, comments about your academic performance, goals, and accomplishments.
3. A copy of the Student Aid Report (SAR) that you receive from the FAFSA, showing the amount of your Estimated Family Contribution (EFC) along with all FAFSA data sheets.
4. An copy of your most recent semester grades and/or an official transcript.

Only complete applications will be considered.
All applications must be postmarked no later than May 1, 2021.
