


Consider the ROI





Apprenticeships

The Maine Apprenticeship Program assists in setting up structured, yet flexible training programs designed to meet the specific needs of Maine employers through onthe-job learning and related classroom instruction.

Apprenticeship Programs can be sponsored by employers, employer associations, or labor/management groups that can hire and train in a working situation.



Financial Aid Is Still Available

- Federal Pell and Direct Loans still available
- Maine State Grant deadline extended
- USM extended merit aid consideration to July 1st
- Colleges will usually consider transfer students for merit aid as early as the Spring semester.



Maine's Free College Scholarship

High school graduates from the Classes of 2020, 2021, 2022, and 2023 all qualify for a Free College Scholarship that pays 100% of tuition and mandatory fees at any one of Maine's seven community colleges across the state.

- Have a high school diploma or equivalent. Be a Maine resident.
- Enroll full time, earning 30 credits per year.
- Pursue an associate degree or one-year certificate.
- Accept all federal and state grants first. This is a last-dollar scholarship.
