



What Does Your School's Scholarship Page Look Like?

#### Use Folders to Keep Yourself Organized!







Encourage students to connect with someone to help guide, proofread, encourage & empower.

- Teacher
- Parent/Child
- Mentor
- Coach



#### The Essay

- The What, How and Why of your plan goes here
  - What are your going to do?
  - How are your going to do it?
  - Why do you want to do it?
- Tailor essays for each application
- Proofread and have someone else do the same



- Know your application committee
  - Specific Scholarship = Knowledgeable
     Audience
  - General Scholarship = Teachable Audience
- Adapt essay to align with institutional missions
