A. Mastering StudentAid.gov Accounts: Tips & Troubleshooting for a Smoother

FAFSA Experience

A verified and accessible StudentAid.gov account (commonly known as an FSA ID) is essential for completing the FAFSA and accessing federal student aid. However, many students and parents encounter roadblocks when creating or using their accounts. In this session, we'll share proactive tips to help prevent common issues and walk through effective solutions for problems like locked accounts and forgotten login credentials. We'll also explain the process for contributors who do not have a Social Security number. This session will equip you with the tools to troubleshoot with confidence.

B. CSS Profile Overview

You asked, and we listened! Here is a session dedicated to the CSS Profile. In this session, we'll cover the most common questions we receive about the form, discuss how it differs from the FAFSA, and share what you need to know when working with students. We'll also take a look inside the form and provide targeted tips and general insight on getting the CSS Profile completed.

C. FAFSA Demonstration: Navigate the New Look with Confidence

The FAFSA received a glow up! With updated terminology and a redesigned process flow, the form's look and feel have evolved over the past couple of years. This year's most notable change is a simpler, more streamlined way for contributors to be invited and provide their information. In this session, we'll walk through the FAFSA step-by-step, focusing on the sections that commonly raise questions—especially around contributor roles, consent, and data sharing.

D. Navigating the FAFSA in Unusual Circumstances

Some prospective college students are preparing for their higher education journey without family support. They may be homeless, self-supporting, and/or dealing with difficult family circumstances. In this session, we'll discuss the financial aid process for students in these situations, including how to file the FAFSA and communicate their circumstances to the financial aid office. E. After the FAFSA: Next Steps

Filing the FAFSA is the first, not the last step in the financial aid process. During this session we'll cover what needs to happen AFTER the FAFSA is submitted and share resources to support both you and your students. Topics to be discussed include financial aid offers (when to expect them and how to interpret and compare multiple offers), appeals, verification, and follow-up documentation for unique circumstances. We'll provide an update on FAME's FAFSA Portal, a tool that can be used to track student's FAFSA filing status, and share other resources.

F. Scholarship Strategies & Tools
